1. The matter relates to recruitment process of Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA).

2. The petitioner challenges the manner in which marks has been awarded by the authority. It has been submitted that the same is contrary to the revised guidelines for selection of ASHA dated 27th June, 2012.

3. None represents the private respondent.

4. Be it recorded that the private respondent is in service from the year 2023.

5. The Sub-Divisional Officer, Baruipur Sub-Division, South 24-Parganas, is directed to file a report clearly disclosing the full marks of the examination conducted. Total marks on which weightage was given to the candidates in respect of the educational qualification and the interview.

6. The report shall also specify as to whether the marks obtained in the optional subject by the private respondent was added in the educational score.

7. Let such report be prepared and circulated by 22nd May, 2026.

8. Re-list the matter on 15th June, 2026.

9. It will be open for the petitioner to file exception to the same prior to the adjourned date.

10. Let further notice be issued upon the non-appearing respondents indicating the order of the Court.

11. The name of the learned advocate representing the State respondents was wrongly recorded in the order dated 17th September, 2025.

12. Let it be recorded that Mr. Arkadipta Sengupta, learned advocate, represented the State respondents on the said date.

13. All parties shall act on the basis of a server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
