5) From submissions made on behalf of parties and contents of communication dated 31st August, 2026, it appears that after being enlarged on bail petitioner is seeking an order from this Court by filing present writ petition under Article 226 which in effect may prevent concerned police authorities to carry out investigation in connection with aforesaid criminal prosecution and any order on this writ petition may be taken advantage of by petitioner.

6) Taking note of the case made out in this writ petition, concerned Investigating Officer in Jibantala Police Station Case No. 599/2026 dated 26th June, 2026 is directed to carry out investigation in accordance with law and it is expected that petitioner shall cooperate with Investigating Officer.

7) Writ petition stands disposed of.
