1. All these appeals are arising out of a judgment of conviction for life. The applications are for suspension of sentence.
2. Having regard to the nature of the evidence and the appreciation of such findings of the learned Single Judge in arriving at the conclusion, we are, prima facie, of the view that no ground is being made out for suspension of sentence.
3. The aforesaid observation, however, shall not limit our view when we consider the appeals on merits.
4. Mr. Sekhar Kumar Basu, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of some of the appellant, has fairly submitted that all the appeals are to be decided on merits.
5. On the prayer of the learned Counsel for the appellants, the matter shall be listed on 22nd August, 2024 fairly at the top.
6. The parties shall file their law notes within four weeks from date.
7. All applications are disposed of in terms of the aforesaid order.
