1. Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the petitioners is taken on record.
2. Document filed in support of depositing Court fee is taken on record.
3. Petitioners pray for consideration of their candidature in 1st State Level Selection Test, 2016 (Upper Primary) being untrained candidates in the event vacancies are available under the category of Scheduled Tribe Bengali.
4. It is also submitted that even after accommodating trained candidates under the said category i.e. Scheduled Tribe Bengali there will remain certain vacant posts where petitioners can be accommodated.

5. Learned advocates representing the West Bengal Central School Service Commission and Union of India have submitted that petitioners did not participate in the personality test and the panel is expiring today, 25th September, 2025.
6. On behalf of the Commission it is submitted that writ petition is not maintainable.
7. Having considered the issue involved in this writ petition, Court finds that there is no scope for passing any interim order.
8. Let affidavit-in-opposition to this writ petition be filed by four weeks after ensuing Puja vacation and affidavit-in-reply, thereto if any, be filed by two weeks thereafter.
9. Petitioners shall be at liberty to mention the matter before the appropriate Bench for hearing after the time fixed hereinabove for exchanging affidavits.
10. Point of maintainability is kept open.
