This is an application wherein petitioner has prayed for quashing of the proceeding in connection with C Case No. 804 of 2013 alleging offence under section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, presently pending before learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 16th Court Calcutta.

Being aggrieved by the impugned proceeding learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is one of the Directors of the Company namely M/s. Satya Distribution Services Ltd., but the complaint has been lodged against the present petitioner only without impleading the company as an accused. He further submits that the company has issued a cheque which they had not encashed and thereafter they had initiated the instant criminal proceeding alleging that the price of the supplied goods amounting to Rs. 11,92,557/ has not been paid yet. He further submits that dispute is purely civil in nature and continuance of the further proceeding will be a mere abuse of the process of the Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the application is admitted.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the application upon the State through the office of the Public Prosecutor, High Court, Calcutta and upon the learned counsel appearing for the opposite party no. 2 in course of the day.

Petitioner will be at liberty to pray for accommodation before the court below on 5th February, 2026.
