1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that the interim order was in force till six weeks after the Puja Vacation of 2024 and the instant application has been filed on 13th February, 2025, i.e., after expiry of the interim order and accordingly prays for re-imposition and extension of the same.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party no.2 has raised formal objection.
4. Considering all facts and circumstances, the interim order stands re-imposed and extended till one week after the puja vacation or until further order, whichever is earlier.
