1. The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ application that the petitioner has obtained two personal loans of Rs. 6,40,000/- and Rs. 6,00,000/- respectively. Out of the total loan amount of Rs. 12,40,000/-, the petitioner has paid the amount of Rs. 6,45,196/- and Rs. 3,65,444/-. Subsequently, the petitioner could not pay the said amounts due to some personal difficulties. The salary of the petitioner was put on hold by the authorities of the petitioner due to no pay for no work but the Bank has attached the salary account of the petitioner and the petitioner is not getting any amount from the salary account.
2. In view of the above, this Court finds that a report is required to be filed by the Bank.
3. Accordingly, the learned advocate appearing for the State Bank of India is directed to file the report within three weeks after serving the copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The petitioner is at liberty to file exception, if any, within a week thereafter.

4. List the matter on April 28, 2026 under the same heading.
