1. At the time of call accommodation is prayed for on behalf of petitioners.
2. However, respondent nos.6 to 8, 10 to 12 and State respondents are represented by learned advocates.
3. By presenting this writ petition prayer is made for directing concerned police authorities to take steps based on representation dated 29th June, 2026 and investigate matter taking note of such prayer couched in this writ petition. Prayer made on behalf of petitioners for adjournment is refused since no purpose would be sub-served in keeping this writ petition pending.
