1. The petitioners are casual workers in Damodar Valley Corporation. They seek regularization.

2. Learned advocate representing the respondent authority raises objection with regard to the maintainability of the writ petition.

3. The issue has to be decided upon exchange of affidavits.

4. Let affidavit-in-opposition be prepared and circulated within a period of six weeks from date. Reply, if any, may be filed within a fortnight thereafter.

5. Liberty to mention the matter for hearing immediately on completion of the aforesaid time period.

6. Leave granted to the petitioners to file appropriate application in the event any coercive step is taken against them by the respondent authority.

7. All parties shall act on the basis of a server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
