1. Contempt application is heard in presence of the learned advocate representing the applicants.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the applicants that direction contained in paragraph 30 of the judgment dated 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 passed on a batch of writ petitions, first one being *WPA 12505 of 2025 (Sanjoy Kumar Doloi & Anr. vs. The State of West Bengal & Ors.)* is violated. It is also submitted that certain ‘tainted’ candidates were permitted to participate in the selection process, *i.e.*, 2<sup>nd</sup> State Level Selection Test, 2025 for classes IX-X and XI-XII.
3. During course of hearing, it is taken into consideration that concerned authority of the West Bengal Central School Service Commission issued a list of ‘tainted’ candidates which was challenged before this Court by some of the candidates on filing writ petitions and those writ petitions were dismissed.

4. In view of steps taken by the West Bengal Central School Service Commission by publishing list of 'tainted' candidates, question arises how it can be contended before this Court that direction contained in paragraph 30 of the judgment dated 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 is violated.
5. Learned advocate representing the applicant has prayed for accommodation to answer the query of this Court.
6. List the matter under the same heading for further consideration in the Monthly Combined List of December, 2025.
