1. Present petition has been filed for quashing of the domestic violence proceedings filed by the opposite party wife.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the opposite party wife lodged a police case against the petitioners and the members of his family which ultimately ended and acquittal after trial of 14 years before the learned 9th Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Nagpur. Learned Counsel submits that thereafter the petitioner husband had also filed a divorce petition on the ground of cruelty at Nagpur in which divorce was granted to the petitioner / husband on the ground of cruelty. Learned counsel submits now the opposite party wife has initiated the proceeding under Domestic Violence Act on the same set of facts which has already been considered by the competent Court of jurisdiction.
