1. The petitioner was serving in the Border Security Force. He has been dismissed from service. The appeal preferred against the dismissal order has been affirmed by the appellate authority. The petitioner is aggrieved by the same.

3. The respondents shall file affidavit-in-opposition within six weeks from date; reply thereto, if any, by a fortnight thereafter.
