1. Let affidavit-of-service, as filed in Court, be kept on record.
2. The petitioner's grievance is that his application for compassionate appointment has been refused by a reasoned order pursuant to the order of this Hon'ble Court dated April 7, 2026.
3. Mr. Chattopadhyay, learned Advocate appearing for the Food Corporation of India, submits that the prevalent scheme for compassionate appointment is such that the petitioner has sought for application in a "dying cadre" in which no further appointments are taking place.
4. Let a report be filed disclosing the particulars of such cadre and as to whether the petitioner can be accommodated on compassionate

ground in a separate department subject to availability of the vacancies.

5. Let such report by way of an affidavit be filed by September 30, 2026.

6. Exception thereto, be filed by October 9, 2026.

7. List this matter on October 12, 2026 under the heading "Motion".
