1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record. The affidavit of service reveals that service could not be effected on the private respondent. The track report reveals that service failed as the recipient is “deceased”.

2. Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that he shall take instruction as regards status of the private respondent.

3. The petitioner submits that he has not been given electricity supply despite applying therefor.

4. Learned Advocate appearing for the WBSEDCL submits that the petitioner’s application could not be processed since requisite documents are lacking.

5. Attention of this Court is drawn to a letter dated July 20, 2026 (Annexure P-3 at page 19) to show that the petitioner was informed about such fact.

6. The letter uses a vague expression “lack of requisite documents”. The same does not indicate which documents are lacking for the petitioner’s application for electricity supply to be treated as complete.

7. In such view of the matter, the WBSEDCL Authorities are directed to furnish a proper letter specifically indicating the documents which are required to be furnished by the petitioner. Let such letter be issued to the petitioner within a week from date.

8. List this matter on September 21, 2026.
