It appears that, with a view to partitioning the property amicably, the parties engaged an Amin. The complaint essentially alleges that the Amin prepared a map under the influence of the petitioner. Prima facie, it does not appear that any criminality is involved in the present case.

Accordingly, there shall be an interim order of stay of all further proceedings arising out of Krishnagar Kotwali Police Station Case No. 616 of 2026 dated June 02, 2026, under Sections 316(2), 318(4), and 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, for a period of six months from date or until further order, whichever is earlier.

The petitioner shall serve a copy of this revisional application upon the opposite parties, together with an intimation that the matter shall be listed for hearing in the

Combined Monthly List of January, 2027, under the heading “Contested Application”.

The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
