1. Present petition has been filed for quashing of the proceedings in Hingalganj Police Station Case No. 155 of 2025 dated 5th July, 2025 arising out of G.R. Case No. 3350 of 2025 under Section 341/323/354/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that that it was a property dispute. Learned counsel submits that even as per the complaint lodged by the defacto complainant the alleged incident is of March, 2024 and FIR was lodged in July, 2025.
3. The translated copy of the complaint has been placed on record. Let it be taken on record.
4. Court has perused the complaint. The complaint reveals that the incident is of March, 2024 and the FIR has been lodged on July, 2025. The Court considers that there are sufficient reasons to admitting the petitioners and hearing of the parties.

6. Affidavit of service be filed.
7. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners have already surrendered and have been admitted to bail.
