1. The petitioner complains of inaction on the part of the respondent CESC Authorities in not effecting electricity supply at the petitioner's residential premises.

2. Mr. Mukherjee, learned Advocate appearing for the respondent CESC Authorities submits that the address whereat the petitioner seeks electricity supply appears to be in respect of a property constructed over the wetlands.

3. It is submitted that the CESC Authorities have already written to the Chief Technical Officer, East Kolkata Wetlands Management Authority to indicate as to whether the address whereat the petitioner seeks electricity supply falls on wetlands or not.

4. It is further submitted that despite such letter having been written on March 13, 2026,

no reply has yet been received and as such, the CESC Authorities have not been processed the petitioner's application.

5. As prayed for, let the Chief Technical Officer, East Kolkata Wetlands Management Authority be added as a party respondent to the writ petition.

6. The petitioner shall amend the cause title of the writ petition and serve a copy of the writ petition upon the added respondent within a week from date.

7. List this matter for further consideration on September 23, 2026.
