Re: CRAN 1 of 2025

The petitioners herein seeks for extension of interim order granted by this court vide order dated 17th September, 2025.

Learned counsel for the defacto-complainant submits that such protection should not be extended as the petitioners are habitual offender and they are not cooperating with the Investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the extension prayer can be considered only on condition that the petitioners shall cooperate with the Investigating agency in respect of the investigation.

Having heard learned counsel for both the parties, the interim order, granted vide order dated 17.9.2025 is extended for a period of seven weeks from date, on condition that the petitioners shall make all sorts of cooperation with the Investigating agency and in case of any notice served upon them under Section 35(3) of the BNSS, 2023 by the Investigating agency, they will comply such notice.

Let the matter appear six weeks hence.

CRAN 1 of 2025 is accordingly disposed of.
