Prima facie, it appears that the learned Judicial Magistrate, 16th Court at Calcutta, lacks jurisdiction to receive the complaint in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court rendered in the case of ***Jai Balaji Industries Limited v. Heg Ltd.***, reported at **2025 SCC OnLine SC 2581**.

In view of the aforesaid, there shall be an interim order of stay of all further proceedings in Complaint Case No. 189604 of 2026 under Sections 25 and 27 of the Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007, pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 16th Court at Calcutta, for a period of six months from date or until further order, whichever is earlier.

The petitioners shall serve a copy of this revisional application upon the opposite parties, with an intimation that the matter shall be listed for hearing in the Combined Monthly List of January, 2027, under the heading "Contested Application".

The petitioners shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
