The petitioner is a practising advocate at Kalyani Court. Opposite Party No. 2 lodged a complaint against her, alleging, inter alia, that the petitioner had obtained her signatures on blank papers and had thereafter lodged various complaints against different authorities by using the said signatures.

Upon completion of the investigation, the investigating agency submitted a chargesheet under Sections 316(2), 351(2), and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. A bare perusal of the chargesheet, however, does not disclose any material evidence collected against the petitioner in the course of the investigation. In fact, the chargesheet reveals that no document whatsoever was seized during the course of the investigation.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, there shall be an interim order of stay of all further proceedings in connection with S.L. No. 1304 of 2025, arising out of Kalyani Police Station Case No. 503 of 2025 dated 21.05.2025, under Sections 336(3),

336(4), 318(4), 351(2), and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, for a period of six months from date or until further order, whichever is earlier.

The petitioner shall serve a copy of this revisional application upon the opposite parties, with an intimation that the matter shall be listed for hearing in the Combined Monthly List of January, 2027, under the heading "Contested Application".

The petitioner shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.

Urgent photostat certified copies of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties upon compliance of all necessary formalities.
