1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today by the petitioner is taken on record.
2. Private respondent No.6 remains unrepresented in Court today.
3. The postal tracking report reveals that the article was kept on hold at the instance of the assessee.
4. In view of such status, the Officer-in-Charge of Jhalda Police Station is directed to serve a notice and communicate this order to the private respondent No.6 i.e. Mr. Rajen Mahato, son of Late Mantu Ram Mahato, residing at Village Olgara, P.O. Khamar, P.S. Jhalda, District Purulia, West Bengal 723202 within 48 hours from the date of communication of this order and to ensure his presence on the adjourned date, failing

which appropriate orders shall be passed in accordance with law in absence of the private respondent No.6.

5. The Registrar Administration (L & OM) is directed to communicate this order to the aforesaid police station forthwith.
6. Let this matter be listed on 16.09.2026 under the heading “**Leave Matter**”.
7. Till the next date of hearing the respondent authorities shall not take any steps/decision with regard to induction of partners in partnership in the existing licence.
