1. Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioners is taken on record.
2. By the present writ petition the petitioners seek for approval of their services as Assistant Teachers from February, 2021 and grant consequential benefits to the petitioners.
3. Mr. Sudipta Dasgupta, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners participated in the recruitment process of 2020. The petitioners had the necessary qualifications and were eligible to be appointed. However, since appointment was not granted, the petitioners approached this Court by filing writ petitions being WPA 2062 of 2021 and WPA 2059 of 2021 respectively. Pursuant to order passed in the aforesaid writ petitions the petitioners were given appointment in the year 2023. The candidates who were

successful have been given appointment since February, 2021. The petitioners seek for notional benefits from February, 2021. He relies on the decision passed in *Mashidur Hoque and another –versus- State of West Bengal & ors. (In re : WPA 22152 of 2024 and WPA 24234 of 2024)*.

4. Mr. Subhadeep Maitra, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the State seeks accommodation to take instruction.

5. State is directed to furnish report by the returnable date.

6. List this matter on **13th April, 2026** under the same heading.
