Affidavit of service be kept with the record.

It is submitted by the learned Advocate for the CBI that the instant matter is required to be heard by this Court at the earliest because the petitioner was found guilty and convicted by both the Trial Court as well as in the First Appellate Court. Therefore, the matter may be listed at an early date.

It is also submitted that the opposite party shall file an affidavit in the instant matter within 10 days.

Therefore, the opposite party/CBI is at liberty to file affidavit by 28th February, 2023 and serve a copy of the same to the learned Advocate for the petitioner.

The petitioner is at liberty to file affidavit-in-reply within 7 days thereafter.

The matter be listed for final hearing under the heading "Specially Fixed Matter" on 10th March, 2023 at 2 p.m.

The interim order of stay be extended till 19th March, 2023.

Learned Advocate for the opposite party has raised objection against the prayer for extension of interim order filed by the petitioner.
