Orders dated August 10, 2026 and August 28, 2026 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division) 2nd Court at Alipore in Money Execution Case No. 19651 of 2013 is under challenge in this civil revision application.

Mr. Chatterjee, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner draws the attention of the Court to the order dated August 10, 2026 directing the Officer in-Charge of the concerned police station to execute the warrant of arrest against the petitioner and to produce him in custody before that Court adhering to the principles contemplated under Section 55(3) of the Civil Procedure Code and following the procedure of arrest subject to the conditions laid down under the proviso clauses of Section 55 of the Civil Procedure Code.

Considering the urgency involved in this matter, this matter was taken up out of turn.

Mr. Banerjee, learned advocate, appears and submits that has instruction to appear on behalf of the opposite-party.

Learned advocate-on-record is directed to serve a copy of this civil revision application upon Mr. Banerjee, learned advocate, in course of this day.

Mr. Chatterjee submits considering the nature of the impugned order an interim order of protection be granted to the petitioner for a limited period.

This Court finds that the petitioner was directed to pay a sum of about 6 lacs.

On a query of the Court as to how soon the said amount can be paid or secured by way of bank guarantee, Mr. Chatterjee prays for an accommodation. He submits that this matter be taken up on September 14, 2026.

There shall be an order of stay of operation of the impugned orders till September 15, 2026.

List the matter under the heading 'To be mentioned' on September 14, 2026 to enable the petitioner to revert back with instruction as to how soon the amount of Rs. 6 lacs can be paid or cleared.
