1. The affidavit-in-reply filed today in respect of CAN 3 of 2025 be kept on record.
2. Due to paucity of time, the hearing of the application filed by the alleged contemnor for modification of our previous order cannot be completed.
3. However, it is pointed out by learned counsel for the wife that the alleged contemnor/husband has not paid a single paisa in terms of the order, of which recall has been sought, since June, 2025.
4. Learned counsel for the alleged contemnor submits that some amounts have been paid.

5. Be that as it may, since the entire arrears appear not to have been paid in terms of the parent order, the alleged contemnor shall pay an *ad hoc* amount of Rs. 1 lakh to the appellant/wife by online transfer to the bank account of the wife, as disclosed in the contempt application, within a fortnight from date.
6. The matter shall next be taken up for further hearing on May 08, 2026.
