1. Present petition has been filed for transfer of Matrimonial Suit no. 137 of 2024 from the Court of learned District Judge, Jhargram, to the Court of learned District Judge, Purba Bardhaman.
2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner does not have any source of income and she is presently residing with her mother who is suffering from various age related ailments. Learned counsel submits that already the petition under Domestic Violence Act and maintenance being filed by the petitioner is pending trial before the learned Court at Purba Bardhaman. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner had also filed an application for restitution of conjugal right which is also pending before the learned District Judge, Purba Bardhaman. Learned counsel for the petitioner

submits earlier the respondent / husband had filed an application for judicial separation which was dismissed. Subsequently thereto, the present petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act was filed to harass the petitioner.

3. Issue notice to the opposite party and the learned Advocate representing the opposite party before the learned Trial Court.
4. Affidavit of service be filed.
5. Since the prima facie case is made out, the proceedings in Matrimonial Suit No. 137 of 2024 pending before the learned District Judge, Jhargram, be stayed till 31st July, 2025, or until further order whichever is earlier.
6. Copy of the order be also served upon the opposite party and the learned advocate representing the opposite party.
7. Let the matter appear in the **Combined Monthly List of July, 2025.**
8. All parties shall act on the basis of the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
