1. Learned advocates for the parties are present.
2. The application for condonation of delay being CAN 1 of 2025 is taken up for consideration.
3. Heard learned advocates. Perused the petition filed. The delay in preferring this appeal is 628 days. However, as the appellants have furnished sufficient grounds for condonation of delay, in the interest of justice, delay in preferring this appeal is condoned and the appeal is admitted.
