It appears that the Learned Magistrate in the court below has not complied with the 1st proviso to Section 223 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in taking cognizance and issuing process against the petitioners. The petitioners being the accused persons were not heard by the Learned Magistrate.

In that view of the matter, there will be a stay of all further proceedings of Complaint Case No.807C/2025 pending before the Judicial Magistrate, 3rd Court, Bankura under Section 115(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, for a period of 12 weeks from date.

Let the petitioners serve a copy of the application upon the opposite parties intimating that this matter shall be taken up for hearing after six weeks under the heading "Contested Application".

The petitioners shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
