2. It appears that CAN 2 of 2017 (Old No. CAN 12225 of 2017) is an application for enhancement of monthly alimony to the respondent/wife. The appeal has been filed by the appellant/husband challenging an order of dismissal of a petition for divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion.
