Considering the issue involved in this writ petition Mr. Priyabrata Batabyal, learned State Advocate led by Mr. Soumitra Bandyopadhyay, learned Senior State Advocate submits that, the subject land was acquired in the year **1956** and the land then in **1956** was situated within the territory of the **State of Bihar**. Presently, the land is situated in the State of West Bengal but no records of **1956** are available with the State of West Bengal.

Be that as it may, the respondent no.4 shall file a report in the form of affidavit in the light of the case made out in the writ petition and the impugned order dated **April 28, 2023, Annexure-P5 at page 27** to the writ petition on or before **March 5, 2025** upon a copy being furnished to Mr. Saibal Acharya, learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to file exception on or before ***March 20, 2025***.

The writ petition shall appear under the heading “***For Orders***” on ***April 3, 2025***.
