The petitioner is the brother of the de facto complainant/opposite party no.1. Petitioner no.2 is the wife of petitioner no.1.

Prima facie it appears that the dispute between the parties is civil in nature. The allegation of the de facto complainant revolves around mutation of the relevant record of rights in respect of a landed property in the name of the petitioners.

It is alleged that the petitioner no.1 has illegally transferred the property in favour of petitioner no.2, though opposite party no.1 is the lawful owner of the said property. It appears that opposite party no.1 has already filed a civil suit involving the same issue.

In view of the aforesaid, there will be a stay of GR Case No.1294/2023 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arambag, Hooghly arising out of Khanakul P.S. Case No.597/2023 dated August 24, 2023 under Section 420/406/465/467/468/471/120B of the Indian Penal Code for a period of 12 weeks from date.

The petitioners shall serve a copy of the application to the opposite parties intimating that this matter shall be taken up for hearing under the heading “Contested Application” after one month.

The petitioners shall file an affidavit of service on the next date of hearing.
