1. The learned senior advocate representing the writ petitioners/respondents in MAT 1982 of 2025 and MAT 2231 of 2025 submits that he will be filing an opposition in CAN 1 of 2025 being the Stay Application in MAT 1982 of 2025 within two weeks from date.
2. The learned advocate for the appellant/s submits that he will be filing convenient paper books to facilitate consideration of the matter with a view to final disposal and also a reply to the opposition being filed by the writ petitioners/respondents, if so required, within three weeks from date.
3. We also reserve liberty to the learned senior advocate for the writ petitioners/respondents to submit a compilation of relevant documents arranged in chronological order with reference to the writ records for consideration. We are also of the opinion that the learned advocate/s for the Union of India would obtain instructions as to whether any action has been taken against the so called erring officials who took the decision to grant the benefit.
4. Learned senior advocate submits that till date no contempt application has been filed in implementation of the judgment of the learned Single Judge.

5. We, therefore, have not considered the prayer of the appellants for any interim relief.
