1. The petitioner has retired from service on attaining his normal age of superannuation on January 31, 2024. PPO was issued in his favour on June 11, 2025.

2. Grievance of the petitioner is that the last pay drawn by him has been wrongly mentioned in the PPO.

3. The petitioner refers to the fixation of pay made by the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education) and submits that his last pay drawn is Rs.1,01,400/- and not Rs.98,400/- as shown in the PPO.

4. Prayer has been made to direct the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education) to rectify the PPO.

5. Learned advocate representing the State respondent relies on the instruction forwarded by the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education), Nadia. The same mentions about wrong fixation of pay of the petitioner.

6. Copy of the instruction forwarded by the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education) has been made over to the learned advocate for the petitioner.
7. Re-list the matter for further consideration on February 23, 2026.
8. Report filed by the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education) be retained with the records.
9. Leave is granted to the learned advocate for the petitioner to file exception to the same within a period of three weeks.
