Supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.

Petitioner contention is that the impugned proceeding is a gross abuse of the process of the Court, in view of the fact that the necessary ingredients to constitute a cognizable case against the petitioner is absent from the contents of the FIR and the police has submitted charge-sheet against the petitioner after making a perfunctory investigation.

The opposite party no. 2 has implicated the name of the petitioner at a later stage and in order to take revenge from the petitioner with an ulterior motive as the brother of the opposite party no. 2 get in contact with the petitioner through a matrimonial website for marriage proposal and for a period of time they were in relationship. But such relationship had never gone further due to some discord. Therefore, the allegation made in the FIR even if taken at the face value does not constitute any offence as alleged.

Having considered the submission made on behalf of the petitioner the present application being CRR 4741 of

2024 is hereby disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to make a prayer for discharge before the Court below inter alia on the basis of submissions made in the instant application.

In the event of making such discharge prayer by the petitioner before the Court below he will dispose of such application at the earliest, in accordance with law without being influenced by any observation made herein.
