This is a contempt proceeding arising from an
order dated **August 6, 2025** passed by this Court.

Mr. Manas Kumar Ghosh, learned Advocate
appears for the petitioner.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner
submits that, a new incumbent has come and joined the
post of the alleged contemnor.

In view of the above, the petitioner shall be at liberty to implead the new incumbent as the alleged contemnor in the proceeding.

The formal impleadment shall be carried out and effected in the cause title of the original contempt application and wherever it is required by putting the signature of the learned advocate on record for the petitioner.

The petitioner then shall serve a copy of the amended contempt application upon the new incumbent and file affidavit-of-service when the matter shall be taken up next.

Pendency of this contempt application shall not preclude the alleged contemnor to carry out the direction of this Court in the mean time and to file a compliance report before this Court on the next day.

In the event the Court finds non-compliance of its direction, the Court may proceed to issue Rule on the next day.

The matter shall appear under the heading **“Contempt Application”** on **July 3, 2026**.
