1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. Receipt showing submission of deficit Court fees filed in Court today be retained with the records.
3. The petitioners participated in the 2nd SLST-2025 for recruitment of assistant teachers. On publication of the preliminary model answer key, the petitioners raised objections in respect of a couple of questions. The objections were considered by the Commission and the final answer key has been published. There is no change in the answers of the preliminary questions with the final answer key.

4. According to the petitioners, they have answered the questions relying on the study material from the books which have an ISBN number.
5. It has been submitted that the said books are being taught in Classes- 'XI' & 'XII' in government sponsored/aided schools.
6. Learned advocate representing the Commission submits that out of fifteen petitioners, eight of them did not raise any objection before the Commission.
7. Learned advocate representing the State is directed to revert with instruction as to whether the books, ISBN number of which is annexed to the writ petition, are recognized by the education department of the State and whether these books are taught in the government sponsored/aided schools.
8. Relist the matter for further consideration on 22nd December, 2025.
