The petitioners seek quashing of GR 6791 of 2022 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baruipur, South 24 Parganas.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners lodged a complaint against the private opposite party prior to the present application on 22nd October, 2022 which was registered as Baruipur Police Station case no. 1644 of 2022. On the same date, the private opposite party also lodged a complaint against the petitioners which was registered as Baruipur Police Station case no.1665 of 2022. Several medical documents have been annexed with the present application which *prima facie* indicate that the petitioners sustained injuries in the alleged incident. Learned counsel submits that no injury was sustained by the private opposite party in the instant case. Charge sheets have been submitted in both the cases.

The matter needs to be heard on merits.

The petitioners are directed to serve copy of the application along with annexure thereto upon the opposite parties and file affidavit of service on the adjourned date.

Let the matter appear under the heading 'Contested Application' in the monthly list of April, 2025.

Further proceedings of GR 6791 of 2022 pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baruipur, South 24

Parganas be stayed till 30th April, 2025 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.
