1. This revisional application assails an order dated August 12, 2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court-I, Barrackpore, North 24-Parganas in Misc. Case No. 175 of 2025 (Act VIII) whereby the opposite party has been permitted to visit his minor son twice a month within the premises of Barrackpore Sub-Divisional Court.

2. Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that such an application has been filed with a mala fide motive only to harass the petitioner inasmuch as the opposite could have got the same relief by filing an appropriate application in the pending matrimonial proceeding between the parties before the learned Additional District Judge, Sealdah. It is submitted that the matrimonial suit being Matrimonial Suit No. 74 of 2024 instituted by the opposite party is prior in point of time and the opposite party could have

filed appropriate application in the said suit itself praying for the same relief.

3. The petitioner shall serve a copy of the revisional application along with notice on the opposite party intimating the opposite party that the matter shall be taken up next on June 11, 2026.

4. The petitioner shall file affidavit of service on the returnable date.
