Records reveal that the appellant's husband died in-harness while working as an assistant teacher on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2021. Subsequent thereto, the appellant applied for compassionate appointment. Such prayer was considered and recommended by the District Inspector of Schools (SE), Bankura *vide* memo dated 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 and on the basis of the same, the Commission issued the recommendation letter in favour of the appellant on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2025. As the appellant was not being issued the appointment letter by the Board, she was constrained to prefer the writ petition which has been dismissed observing, *inter alia*, that no right accrued in favour of the appellant since her husband got appointment in a selection process which was subsequently cancelled in view of

the order passed in *State of West Bengal Vs. Baishakhi Bhattacharyya (Chatterjee) & Ors.*

Ms. Neogi, learned advocate appearing for the appellant has pointed out to this Court that the name of the appellant's husband does not feature in the tainted list of candidates as published by the Commission. Let the said list, as placed, be kept on record.

Mr. Singh, learned advocate appearing for the Commission submits that the appellant's claim was recommended by the respondent no. 4 prior to the judgment delivered in the case of *Baishakhi Bhattacharyya (Chatterjee)* (supra).

Ms. Bhattacharyya, learned advocate enters appearance on behalf of the Board.

However, no one appears today on behalf of the State respondents, whose presence is required for final adjudication of the matter.

In view thereof, list the matter for further consideration in the daily supplementary list of this Court on 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

The appellant is directed to communicate this order to the respondent nos. 1 and 4 and to file an affidavit-of-service on the returnable date.
