Since there are some formal defects in this contempt application, Mr. Mohinoor Rahaman, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits, on instruction from his client, that the petitioner shall withdraw this contempt application and file afresh on the self-same charges and cause of action.

Today is the first day.

It appears that, the contempt proceeding arises from an order dated **June 25, 2024**. In the event the contempt proceeding is withdrawn and even though liberty is given to file afresh on the self-same charges and cause of action, then also the question of limitation might crop up.

Substantial justice shall not suffer for procedural latches. The petitioner should not be non-suited for procedural latches.

In view of the above, the petitioner shall be at liberty to take out a proper amendment application of the contempt application.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to mention the contempt application at the appropriate stage and for the time being the same is directed to **go out of list**.
