1. Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.
2. By the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks for recast of the panel for the post of 7th SLST (AT) for classes XI and XII, subject-Physics (PG), category-General Bengali medium.
3. Mr. Prosenjit Mukherjee, learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner despite getting higher marks than the last empanelled candidate has not given appointment.
4. Mr. Pratik Dhar, learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission submits that 19th June, 2023 was the cut off date within which the petitioner was to complete

B.Ed. qualification. The petitioner completed B.Ed. qualification on 8th December, 2023. Thus, as the writ petitioner failed to fulfil the required criteria, he was not empanelled. He seeks to file report.

5. Let such report be filed within two weeks from date. Advance copy of such report be served upon the learned Advocate for the petitioner. Exception to such report, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
6. List this matter after three weeks.
