During course of hearing Mr. Roy Chowdhury, learned advocate representing Life Insurance Corporation of India (for short, 'LIC') submits that one Special Leave to Appeal (C) No(s).17649 of 2024 (The Life Insurance Corporation of India & Ors. vs. Sasikumar A & Anr.) was heard by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 12th August, 2024 and order was passed thereby declining to grant stay of operation of the order impugned in the special leave petition. It was further observed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court

that implementation of the impugned order by the petitioners shall be subject to final outcome of the special leave petition.

2. Copy of the order dated 12th August, 2024 is taken on record.
3. In view of order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 12th August, 2024 in the aforesaid special leave petition, interim order passed earlier stands extended till 31st March, 2026 or until further order, whichever is earlier.
4. Leave is granted to the parties to file appropriate application seeking variation or vacation of the interim order, if situation so arises.
