1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

2. The petitioner participated in the 2nd SLST (AT), 2025 in respect of classes XI and XII. Though the petitioner was issued an Admit Card and his name has appeared in the interview list, but thereafter his candidature has been “rejected due to PG score below 45%”.

3. The petitioner is aggrieved by the same. He submits that he should be given the benefit of the direction passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court on 3rd April, 2025 in Civil Appeal No.4800 of 2024.

4. According to the respondents, the petitioner cannot be provided any relaxation with regard to his

educational qualification in terms of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

5. Whether the petitioner will get the benefit of relaxation with regard to his educational qualification has to be decided.

6. Let the matter appear in the list for further hearing on 13th January, 2026.

7. The candidature of the petitioner shall abide by the result of the instant writ petition.
