1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.

2. The petitioner participated in the 2nd SLST (AT), 2025 in respect of classes XI and XII. Though the petitioner was issued an Admit Card and his name has appeared in the interview list, but thereafter he has been disqualified for interview and lecture demonstration after the verification phase on the ground that he is over-aged.

3. The petitioner is aggrieved by the same. He submits that he should be given the benefit of age

relaxation in terms of the direction passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 3rd April, 2025 in Civil Appeal No.4800 of 2024.

4. According to the respondents, the benefit of age relaxation cannot be extended to the petitioner.

5. Whether the petitioner will get the benefit of age relaxation has to be decided.

6. Let the matter appear in the list for further hearing on 13th January, 2026.

7. The candidature of the petitioner shall abide by the result of the instant writ petition.
