This revisional application assails an order dated August 28, 2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, 2nd Fast Track Court, Chinsurah, Hooghly in Misc. Case No. 100/2022 to the limited extent that it directs payment of alimony pendente lite from the date of the order and not from the date of the application.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the order impugned has been passed on the petitioner's application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

It is submitted that while the learned Trial Court has granted alimony pendente lite in favour of the petitioner, the effect of such order has been given from the date of passing of the order while it is settled law that effect should be given from the

date of the institution of the application for alimony pendente lite.

The petitioner shall serve a copy of the revisional application along with notice on the opposite party intimating the opposite party that the matter shall be taken up next on June 16, 2026. The petitioner shall file affidavit-of-service to that effect on the returnable date.
