2. By the present writ petition, the petitioners seek that they should be declared TET qualified in the year 2022.
3. Mr. Sudipta Dasgupta, learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that as per the report of the expert, the subject question has a typographical error. The West Bengal Board of Primary Education, in the earlier occasion in similar circumstances awarded one mark against wrong question. The petitioners, who are entitled to such mark, if awarded, would qualify in TET 2022.
4. Mr. Subir Sanyal, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the West Bengal Board of Primary Education seeks to file affidavit-in-opposition.

5. Let such affidavit-in-opposition be filed within a period of two weeks; reply, if any, be filed within a week thereafter. Advance copy of the affidavit-in-opposition be served upon the learned Advocate for the petitioners.
