The last order dated **December 13, 2024** speaks for itself.

Three affidavits-of service in each three of these contempt proceedings filed today in Court by the petitioners, are taken on record.

Mr. Rudronil De, learned counsel appears for Sri Suniti Sanfui, the alleged contemnor.

Mr. Gourav Das, learned counsel appears also for Sri Suniti Sanfui, the alleged contemnor.

It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for the alleged contemnor that he is the authority who shall respond to this contempt proceeding and alleged contemnor no. 2 Sri Debasish Sarkar may be expunged from the array of the alleged contemnors and these contempt proceedings.

Mr. Sandip Kumar De, learned counsel submits that he has no objection, if the name of Sri Debasish Sarkar is deleted from the array of the alleged contemnors he is expunged from the scope of the contempt proceeding.

Accordingly, the name of Sri Debasish Sarkar, stands deleted from the array of the alleged contemnors and he stands expunged from the scope of these three contempt proceedings.

Accordingly, the three contempt proceedings shall continue and survives against Sri Suniti Sanfui, the alleged contemnor.

Mr. Rudronil De and Gourav Das, learned counsel submits that an appeal has been preferred from the judgment and order dated **March 11, 2024** being **MAT 2260 of 2024** before the Hon'ble Division Bench.

In view of the above, the hearing of these contempt proceedings stands adjourned for the day. The matter shall appear under the heading '**Contempt Application**' on **March 28, 2025**.
