1. Affidavit of service, as filed, be kept on record.
2. The petitioner is aggrieved that the post for which he had applied, turned out to be one with inadequate and insufficient information.
3. The petitioner had applied for the post of Commerce (PG) in English language. There was a single vacancy available.
4. As it later transpired that the said single seat was for a reserved category, which has not been disclosed to the petitioner. The petitioner is, thus, aggrieved that had this information being disclosed, the petitioner would have applied for one of the many 242 seats available for Commerce (PG) in Bengali.

5. Mr. Bhattacharya, learned advocate appearing for the Commission, seeks to file a report to bring on record certain facts as to why such disclosures had not been made by the Commission.
6. Let such report be filed by April 10, 2026.
7. Exception thereto, if any, by April 17, 2026.
