1. The matter is listed today as “To Be Mentioned” on the supplementary list.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially, the interim order was granted by this Court on December 24, 2025 till January 8, 2026. This Court has further extended the interim order till today and he prayed for extension of interim order.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that after the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has issued a notice for initiation of the contempt proceeding and on receipt of the notice, the respondents have replied to the said notice informing that before the interim order is passed, the respondent authorities have already concluded the tender.
4. This Court considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties.
5. There is an existing interim order, let the same be continued till March 5, 2026 or until further order whichever is earlier.

6. In the meantime, the respondents have filed affidavit-in-opposition within a period of two weeks. Reply, if any, thereto be filed within a week thereafter.
7. List this matter on March 5, 2026.
