Pursuant to service of the contempt petition, Mr. N. C. Bihani, learned senior advocate instructed by Mr. Soumyajit Ghosh, learned advocate, appears for the alleged contemnor.

The petitioner says that in terms of the order under contempt the petitioner has refunded the entire money received on his retirement under the head – employer's share of provident fund and the excess gratuity with interest. The employer/Calcutta State Transport Corporation (in short, CSTC) has paid the principal sum and the arrear pension but the interest on account of arrear pension has not been paid.

Mr. Bihani seeks some time to look into the issue.

Keeping in mind that the principal sum and the current pension are being paid, this Court is minded to give the employer a further opportunity to pay the interest on the arrear amount.

Let this matter on 27th March, 2026.

It is expected that CSTC will pay the interest on the arrear amount within the adjourned date.

CSTC in order to comply with the order may seek assistance of the State Government.
